

## Session 3

### ART CLASS TOPICS

#### Comic Book Drawing

Make your own comics! In this class, campers will improve their basic drawing skills while developing their own unique cartoon or comic book characters. Using classic, contemporary, and manga comics as inspiration, artists will work on drawing figures, facial expressions, action poses, and backgrounds.

#### Totally Textile!

Cut it, shape it, paint it, pin it—sometimes even wear it! There are a million ways to have fun manipulating fabric. Explore printing, dip-dyeing, and painting as you create art from unlikely materials.

#### Ancient Egypt

Pyramids, hieroglyphics, and mummies, oh my! Explore the art and culture of one of the oldest civilizations on earth. In this mixed media class, make pottery, sculpture, and drawings as you create new hieroglyphics, decipher your own Rosetta Stone, and explore the significance of Egyptian art in our modern world.

### MUSIC & DRAMA CLASS TOPICS

#### Boom-Boom-Whack

Come one, come all to the greatest BoomWhacker class of them all! Learn percussion and pitch as you play classic sing-a-long songs and pop favorites in your very own BoomWhacker band. Develop a strong sense of rhythm as you work as an ensemble to play songs for a thumping, whacking, and musical good time.

Dance and play in a music and drama class featuring your favorite folk and fairy tales. Explore classic tales set in enchanted forests with puppets, folk dances, new songs and old favorites. Then, create brand new original stories featuring some of your favorite forest characters. From Little Red to the Gruffalo, there are enchanting mysteries to discover deep in the forest!

#### X is for Xylophone

Combine percussion with melody and what do you get? A class full of fun songs and cool instruments! Learn contemporary and classical songs as you learn to play the xylophone and other unique percussion instruments. Build a xylophone band as you work together to create memorable performances and learn to the basics of reading music.

### MUSIC & DRAMA CLASS TOPICS

#### Ukulele Fun!
