While virtual camp made our 2020 a bit brighter, we are eager to welcome campers back to the Adler Arts Center in 2021. Camp Adler will be smaller this year to ensure our campers and staff have the same quality experience you expect from the Adler Arts Center. Calendar

Camp Adler will offer 2-week full day camps in 2021. An entirely new roster of classes will be offered in each of the 3 sessions, so campers can enroll in multiple sessions without repeating classes. There will be no camp on July 5.

Daily Schedule

The camp day will begin at 9am and finish at 4pm. The building will open at 8:45am and after care will be available from 4:15 – 6pm only. We are unable to accept half-day campers in 2021.

Structure

Campers will check-in with their counselor each morning and remain with their squad in their designated zones for the duration of each day. Each squad will have its own outdoor and indoor studios, as well as a designated bathroom. Art and performance faculty will rotate through each squad's zone, offering each squad age-appropriate curricula in visual and performing arts. Campers will check-out with their counselor at the end of each day.

Classes

Campers will participate in creative art classes and performance classes each session. **Campers will not build a custom schedule this summer;** instead, they will attend classes with the other members of their squad. You can expect the same variety of exciting classes you have come to expect from Camp Adler—we've got painting, cartooning, improv, drumming, ukulele and more! Class Sizes

Camp enrollment will be capped at 48 students per session. Each squad will be capped at 15 people (12 campers, 1 counselor, 1 junior counselor, 1 faculty member). Our enrollment caps will help us maintain good ventilation and social distancing when using our indoor classrooms.

Registration and Cancellation Policy

Registration begins on March 2 for everyone. Tuition and after care fees are non-refundable. We recommend purchasing camp insurance.

Camp Insurance

This year, you may purchase camp insurance for summer 2021. If your plans change before June 7 and you need to withdraw from camp, your tuition and extended care fees will be refunded no questions asked. Conversely, if the Adler Arts Center experiences a coronavirus closure, you will receive a prorated refund.

After Care and Late Pick-up

Enroll in After Care when you register for camp. After Care begins at 4:15pm. After two late pick-ups, children will be automatically enrolled in After Care for the entire two-week session (\$100).

Junior Counselor Program

Each session, the Junior Counselor Program gives 4 young teens the opportunity to learn the basics of camp counseling while participating in all the fun of Camp Adler. Applications are accepted March 2 – 25. Visit the [Junior Counselor Program](#) information on the website to learn more.
