

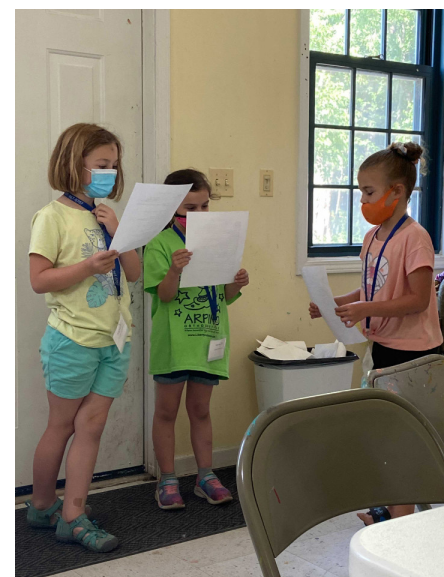


Your weekly guide to Camp Adler's people, projects, and upcoming events.
