

Sketching & Drawing – Adler Arts Center

4 weeks, Oct 9, 16, 23, 30 – 6-9pm

Goal of the class is the student having the ability to draw what they see.

And to learn pencil techniques to create a finished piece of art.

- The class will be broken into two parts, each class will start out with sketching, we will be using still life setups to draw.
- The second part of each class will be focusing on techniques of pencil drawing. We will be working on various “finished” drawings, with each one getting more difficult.

Supplies needed by the student (see pict of supplies)

1. 9 x12 or larger sketching paper. This paper is usually in a spiral bound pad/book. The brand is not important.
2. 9 x 12 drawing paper, Strathmore 400 series drawing paper is very good (has a brown cover)
3. Drawing Pencils, the range of pencils 5H thru 6B – you do not have to get every hardness of pencil, but to have a few of each. There is several good brands to choose from.
4. Kneaded eraser
5. Blending Stumps – a set with a few different sizes.
6. 12” ruler
