COMPENSATION:

\$20 - \$30/hr. Commensurate with experience.

DAYS AND HOURS:

Session I: June 10 - June 28 (3 weeks)

Session II: July 8 - July 26 (3 weeks)

Monday – Friday 8:30am - 4:00pm

Supervise After Care approximately once per week until 6pm.

One evening each session for the Celebration of the Arts.

One day of training prior to the start on June 8th.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Teach theater classes each period daily. There are 4 periods each day. Drama classes have included improv, sketch writing, theater around the world, additional classes based on knowledge/experience created by teacher.
- Teach and develop lesson plans for each class taught.
- Develop supply inventory for projects. Request orders for any necessary supplies within budget from Program Director.
- Maintain assigned classroom space for damage and cleanliness. Report any and all concerns about rooms to Program Director.
- Attend mandatory pre-camp meetings and orientation.
