## JOB SUMMARY

As **ART FACULTY** you will engage campers ages 5 - 11 and junior counselors ages 12-14 in a fun, interactive, and educational environment, encouraging self-expression and artistic exploration. You will lead four daily art classes, each an hour long and designed to introduce campers to various artistic techniques and mediums.

## JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach art classes each period daily. 4 periods each day. Art classes have included drawing, painting, mixed media, portraiture, folk art, outdoor landscapes, murals, etc.
- Develop class curriculum.
- Teach and develop lesson plans for each class taught.
- Develop supply inventory for projects.
  - Request orders for any necessary supplies within budget from Camp and Program Directors.
- Maintain assigned classroom space for damage and cleanliness.
- Organize, matte, conceptualize, display projects for the final Celebration of the Arts the last Thursday evening of each session.
- Attend mandatory pre-camp meetings and orientation.
