## **JOB SUMMARY**

As **Theater Faculty**, you will design and implement age-appropriate theater lessons, facilitate group performances, and collaborate with other faculty members to integrate theater with the broader arts curriculum of Camp Adler. You will lead four daily classes, each an hour long and designed to introduce campers to various fundamentals of acting, improv, storytelling, and stagecraft.

# **JOB RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Teach theater classes each period daily. 4 periods each day.
  - Theater classes have included improv, sketch writing, theater around the world, stagecraft, additional classes based on knowledge/experience created by teacher.
- Develop class curriculum.
- Teach and develop lesson plans for each class taught.
- Develop supply inventory for projects.
  - o Request orders for any necessary supplies within budget from Camp and Program Directors.
- Maintain assigned classroom space for damage and cleanliness.
- Organize, conceptualize, and create performances for the final Celebration of the Arts the last Thursday evening of each session.
- Attend mandatory pre-camp meetings and orientation.
