## JOB SUMMARY

As **Woods Faculty**, you will design and implement fun, age-appropriate lessons that help campers connect with the natural world and express their creativity through the use of natural materials. You will also collaborate with fellow faculty members to integrate outdoor learning into the broader camp curriculum. You will lead four daily classes, each an hour long and designed to encourage campers (Ages 5-11) and junior counselors (ages 12- 14) outdoor exploration and curiosity.

## JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach Woods classes each period daily. 4 periods each day.
  - Woods/Forest classes have included hiking, fort building, natural dying, plant identification, foraging, additional classes based on knowledge/experience created by teacher.
- Develop class curriculum.
- Teach and develop lesson plans for each class taught.
- Develop supply inventory for projects.
  - Request orders for any necessary supplies within budget from Camp and Program Directors.
- Maintain assigned classroom space for damage and cleanliness.
- Organize, conceptualize, and create performances for the final Celebration of the Arts the last Thursday evening of each session.
- Attend mandatory pre-camp meetings and orientation.

- Enthusiasm for working with grades K-8.
