

Individual Music Instruction Policies

2026-2027

Please Note: Important information is highlighted in blue.

PAYMENT OF TUITION

The Individual Music Instruction Term is from August 10, 2026 – May 27, 2027. Tuition is based on the full term of 39 weeks, divided into 3 payments. A new student may enroll at any time during the 39-week term. If enrollment does not begin at the beginning of a billing semester, tuition will be pro-rated according to which week enrollment occurs. The pro-rated tuition will include all lessons remaining in the current billing semester from the date of the student's first lesson. Tuition is due on the dates published on the 2026-2027 Billing Periods and Payment Schedule. We will send an email reminder when tuition is due and post signs around the building.

A \$50 late fee will be applied to students' accounts when tuition has not been received by the tuition due date. **A student will lose their reserved day and time slot in their instructor's schedule if tuition payments and all outstanding charges on the student's account are not received by the time their last paid lesson has concluded.**

ANNUAL ENROLLMENT FEE

The annual enrollment fee per family is \$100. The annual enrollment fee is nonrefundable and is due at the time of enrollment. The enrollment fee helps cover the cost of piano maintenance and tuning, accompanist fees for student performance opportunities, and building maintenance.

METHOD OF PAYMENT

The preferred method of payment for tuition and membership is check or cash. However, the Adler Center also accepts Discover, MasterCard, Visa, and American Express. Customers who wish to pay by credit card over the phone must contact the Adler Center before the tuition due date to submit card information. All students can pay invoices online at www.adlercenter.org. The Adler Arts Center does not retain customer credit card information on file for security reasons.



WITHDRAWAL

Students may withdraw from Individual Music Instruction without a penalty at the conclusion of a billing period. Students who wish to withdraw must submit a notice of withdrawal in writing via email to the administrative office prior to the end of the billing period.

If a current student chooses to withdraw from Individual Music Instruction before the conclusion of a billing period, no refunds or credit will be given for any remaining lessons.

CANCELLATIONS AND MAKE UP LESSONS

PANDEMIC & INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

We seldom cancel lessons due to inclement weather or global pandemics. Make up lessons for pandemic, inclement weather, or random global event closure will be given at the instructors' discretion if their schedule allows. **There are no refunds or credits for canceled lessons due to pandemics, global emergencies, or weather.**

MISSED LESSON POLICY

In the event of any student absence, please notify the Adler Center Administrative Office in advance. It is very important that the administrative office is made aware of the cancellation. The office will notify your instructor and record the information.

IMPORTANT:

The Adler Center does not offer compensation (credit/refund) and does not guarantee a makeup lesson for *student* cancelled lessons that occur for any reason.



But why?

This policy is in respect to our faculty, who reserve a specific time for each student. This time cannot be given away to someone else, thus s/he does not have the opportunity to make up the lost income. Lessons which are cancelled by the instructor for any reason will be made up at a mutually convenient time, or a credit will be given for the missed lesson. Makeups are arranged between the student and the instructor. **The office does not schedule make-up lessons.**

SCHEDULING

Scheduling of lesson day and time is coordinated by the Adler Center Administrative Staff, not our individual music instructors. To permanently change a student's instructor, lesson day, or lesson time please contact the Adler Center at (847)367-0707.

CREDITS

Instructors are provided two weeks after the end of a billing semester to make up missed lessons due to instructor cancellations. If lessons cancelled by the instructor are not made up, a credit will be applied to the student's account. Students withdrawing from individual music instruction will receive a refund for any credits due to instructor cancelled lessons.

DEPORTMENT & PUBLICITY CONSENT

While on the Adler Art Center premises, students and those accompanying them are expected to treat our facilities respectfully. Skates, skateboards, pets, etc. are not allowed in the building. Food and beverages other than water are not permitted in the studios.

Students, parents, and caretakers are expected to behave in a safe, respectful manner while on The Adler Center grounds and in lessons. Inappropriate behavior may result in removal from the school and exclusion from Center events. **Unsafe or aggressive behavior towards our teachers, students and staff is never tolerated.**

DISCOUNTS

FAMILY DISCOUNT

A \$50 discount per billing period, will be applied for each additional immediate family member taking private lessons. The first student will be charged the full tuition amount.

MILITARY DISCOUNT

Active and Retired U.S. Military Members receive a 10% discount on all group and private lessons. Confirmation of status via Military ID will be requested.
